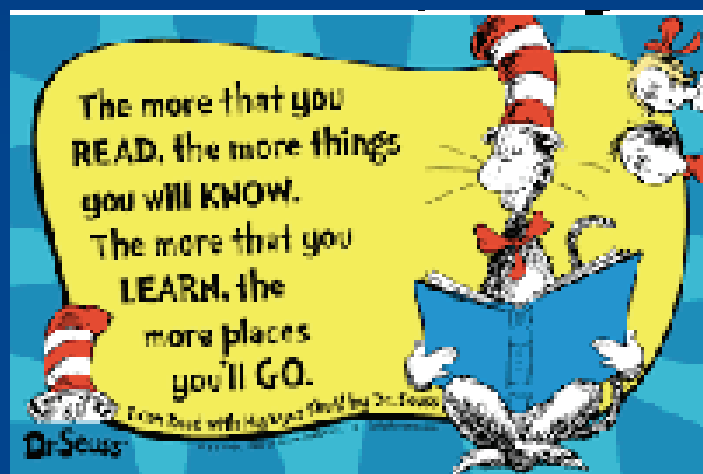

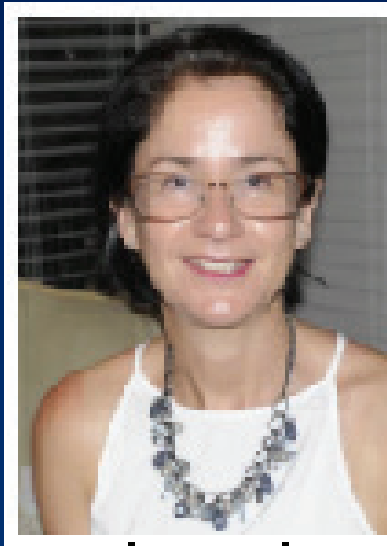

DR SARAH McDONAGH



Dr Sarah McDonagh is an adjunct lecturer in Inclusive Education at Charles Sturt University and a literacy consultant for the Association of Independent Schools and the Catholic Education Diocese of Bathurst. Sarah earned her doctorate in Special Education at the University of Oregon and has research interests in instructional interventions in reading for students identified as at-risk for reading difficulties and scaling up evidence-based practices in applied settings. Her expertise lie in the area of early reading, prevention of reading difficulties, and instructional interventions for students identified at risk for reading difficulties in the early school years. She has vast educational experience as a teacher (primary and special education), academic, researcher, and consultant. Sarah works intensively with schools across the region to support school-wide implementation of effective reading practices. She is currently a co-investigator of a federally funded Australian Research Council Grant and is co-editor of the Australian Journal of Learning Difficulties.
