SCIENCE WEEK - (STEM WEEK) **14 AUGUST - 18 AUGUST 2017**

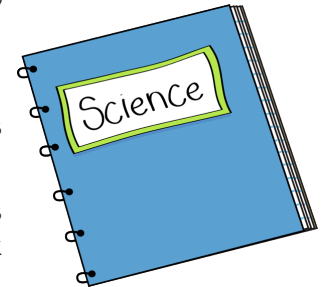
Science Week is coming in week 4 this term and students will be able to enjoy the fun side of science throughout this week.
