



FIRST NATIONS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

Scholarships are offered to First Nations students from both the local community and regional areas. Students and their families are invited to partner with the College to support the aspirations of First Nations Students.

To be eligible students need to be:

- Of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Heritage (Identify as, and recognised by, an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Community).
- Supportive of the Christian ethos and values of our College.
- Willing to embrace the opportunities that Mountain View Adventist College offers and contribute to the rich fabric of our school community.
- Committed to learning.

What to do:

1. Applicants are invited to submit a letter to the Principal, Mr Steyn, with the application form telling him:
 - a little bit about themselves and their experiences at school
 - the type of activities they might wish to be involved in at Mountain View Adventist College, such as sport, music, drama, chapel, leadership etc.
 - the values that are important to them in their life and why

The letter should also let him know about their connection to, and experiences in, the Indigenous community and explain why they would like to complete their education at Mountain View Adventist College.

2. We would also like to hear from the applicant's parents or an appropriate family member about why they are interested in their child learning at Mountain View Adventist College.
3. Applicants may be asked to attend an interview.

Please include the following documents in your First Nations Scholarship application:

- Student letter to the Principal
- A letter from the applicant's parent or family member to the Principal
- Most recent school report
- Most recent NAPLAN report
- Copies of any awards or certificates
- Any relevant family circumstances
- Documentation to confirm the applicant identifying as, and recognised by, an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Community
